The nominations/ recommendations for the Padma Awards will be received only on the online portal www.padmaawards.gov.in designed by the Ministry of Home Affairs. The nomination/ recommendation should contain all relevant details

specified in the format available on the said website, including a citation in narrative form (Maximum 800 words), clearly bringing out the distinguished and exceptional achievement /service recommending of the person recommended in his/her respective field/discipline. While recommending a person online, make sure that all the necessary details are filled properly.

The nominations/ recommendations, if any, may be submitted to the Office of the Assistant Secretary (GA) on or before 4th July, 2025 for further necessary action, a press release from Assistant Secretary (GA) said.

Centre enhances material cost by 9.5% under PM POSHAN scheme

New Delhi, Apr. 10
 The Centre has enhanced the material cost by 9.50 percent under the Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) Scheme. The Scheme is a centrally sponsored scheme under which hot cooked meals are served to over eleven crore students studying in Balvatika and classes 1 to 8 in Government and Government-aided schools. The Union Education Ministry has said that the new rates will be applicable across all the States and UTs



with effect from the 1st of next month. The Central Government will bear the additional cost of 954 crore rupees in 2025-26 due to this enhancement. In addition to the material cost, the Central Government provides about 26 lakh metric tonnes of foodgrains through

the Food Corporation of India. The Government bears 100 per cent cost of foodgrains, including subsidy of approximately nine thousand crore rupees per annum and 100 per cent transportation cost of foodgrains from FCI depot to schools. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Murderer convicted for life by Sessions Judge, A&N Islands

On the basis of FIR vide no. 75/2023 dated 24/06/2023, PS Bambooflat, the investigation was carried out by Inspector K. Abdul Nasir, PS Bambooflat and Charge Sheet No. 87/2023, dated 26/07/2023, U/s 302/201 IPC was submitted against the accused namely Peter

Minj on the allegation of committing murder of his wife at his residence at Tsunami Pahar, Bambooflat. The prosecution case was conducted by Ld. Public Prosecutor, Shri Sumit Kumar Karmakar and Additional Public Prosecutor, Shri Maheshwar Lall. After full fledge trial, the accused was convicted with rigorous life imprisonment under section 302 IPC with a fine of Rs. 10,000/- and 03 years rigorous imprisonment for committing the offence U/s 201 IPC by Shri Sudhir Kumar, the Ld. Sessions Judge, A&N Islands, a press release from Public Prosecutor, High Court & Sessions Court said.

Unwavering Police action secures POCSO conviction

The North & Middle Andaman Police has once again demonstrated the determination in ensuring swift and decisive action against sexual offenders. On 09/04/2025, in a judgment, the Hon'ble Special Judge (POCSO), Shri Subhajit Basu has sentenced the accused Sureen Mondal in a POCSO case vide Crime No. 44/2024 of PS Kalighat to 03 years of Imprisonment along with a fine of Rs.10,000/-.

This significant achievement was the result of the relentless pursuit of justice and

meticulous investigation by SI Kalighat U/s 7/8 of POCSO Act,2012 r.w.s 75(1)(i)/126(2) BNS 2023, spearheading swift legal action against the accused.

This judgement serves as a strong and unequivocal warning that crimes against children will be met with the severest punishments under the law. The A&N Police upholds a zero-tolerance policy against such heinous offenses and remains steadfast in its commitment to ensuring the safety and security of society's most vulnerable members, a press release from SP (N&MA) said.

 - One Muslim member from Muslim voluntary organization working in the fields of public administration, finance, education, social work or culture.

Provided that in case a Union Territory does not have a Legislative Assembly, the Government concerned shall have the discretion to nominate two members from any of the other categories mentioned above.

The names sponsored in the above manner shall duly be considered by a Screening Committee constituted by the A&N Administration and the short listed names will be placed for consideration of the Competent Authority.
