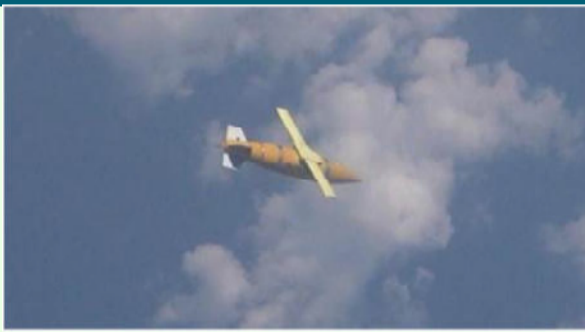

## DRDO conducts successful Release Trials of Long-Range Glide Bomb 'Gaurav' from Su-30 MKI aircraft

New Delhi, Apr.11 (PIB) Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted the Release Trials of Long-Range Glide Bomb (LRGB) 'Gaurav' between April 08-10, 2025 from the Su-30 MKI aircraft. During the trials, the weapon was integrated to multiple stations in different configurations, with land target on Island. The trials successfully demonstrated range close to 100 kms with pin-point accuracy. LRGB 'Gaurav' is a 1,000 kg class glide bomb, designed and developed



indigenously by Development-cum-Research Centre Production Partners - Imarat, Armament Adani Defence Research and Systems & Technologies, Bharat Establishment and various MSMEs. The trials are paving the way towards induction of the weapon into the IAF. The Centre for Military Airworthiness & Certification and Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality

Assurance contributed towards Certification and Quality Assurance. Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh complemented DRDO, IAF and industry for successful development trials of 'Gaurav'. He said the development of LRGB will further enhance the capabilities of the Armed Forces to a great extent. Secretary, Department of Defence R&D and Chairman, DRDO, Dr Samir V Kamat also congratulated the entire DRDO team on conducting the successful release trials.

## Andaman & Nicobar Command to host ANC-ANA Half Marathon on April 13

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 11 In a joint effort to promote fitness and tourism in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Andaman & Nicobar Command (ANC), in collaboration with the Andaman & Nicobar Administration (ANA), is set to host the ANC-ANA Half Marathon on 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 at Netaji Stadium, Sri Vijaya Puram. This event forms part of their shared commitment to the Fit India Movement and the promotion of sports tourism across the Islands. Participants will compete across three

race categories -5 km, 10 km, and 21 km - all of which are timed runs. The event will commence in the early morning, with assembly at 0430 hrs and flag-off at 0500 hrs for half marathon. 10 Km and 05 Km will be fagged off at 0600 hrs and 0645 hrs respectively. Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency,

Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will flag off the 10 km run while the remaining runs will be flagged off by Air Marshal Sajju Balakrishnan, PVSM, VM, Commander-in-Chief, Andaman & Nicobar Command (CINCAN). All race categories will start from Netaji Stadium: 5 km Route: Via

Rina Road and Flag Point, with a turnaround at 2.5 km from Netaji Stadium, then return along the same route. 10 km Route: Follows the same initial route via Rina Road and Flag Point, continuing onto Rajiv Gandhi Road up to the 2.5 km turnaround point on Rajiv Gandhi Road, before heading back. 21 km Route: (Contd. on last page)
