Swachhata Green Leaf Rating Certificates awarded to Hoteliers of Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep



Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 4 In a significant step towards promoting sustainable tourism practices, 34 hoteliers from Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep including Government Guest Houses were awarded Swachhata Green Leaf Rating Certificates today. The Certificates were distributed by Shri Jitendra Srivastava, IAS, Joint Secretary and Mission Director, Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India. Shri Jitendra Srivastava was joined by Shri Sushant Padha, IAS, Assistant Commissioner, Swaraj Dweep, and Smti Gurjeet Kaur, Block Development Officer, CD Block Prothrapur, in presenting the Certificates to the hoteliers.

This achievement demonstrated the commitment of the hoteliers in Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep towards maintaining high standards of hygiene and sanitation, and promoting sustainable tourism practices. The Swachhata Green Leaf Rating system is an initiative of the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, in collaboration with the Ministry of Tourism, aimed at promoting environmental sustainability within the hospitality sector. The system evaluates hotels, resorts, and homestays based on their adherence to safe sanitation practices and environmental sustainability. While addressing the gathering, Shri Jitendra Srivastava, IAS encouraged the hoteliers to participate in Swachhata Green Leaf Rating system showing their involvement towards safe sanitation management in the Islands. He informed the gathering that India is the only country in the world that has adopted Swachhata Green Leaf Rating system and the Government of India is focused for wide publicity and adoption of this system, so that the tourists/guests select the hotels with maximum leaf rating, which, in turn contribute and promote best sanitation practices in the tourism sector. In near future, the hotels not adopting the suitable sanitation practices will be penalized and those adopting good practices will be incentivized. He highlighted the issue of plastic waste, wet waste management and poor public toilet in the Islands which need immediate attention by the UT Administration with the support of PRIs and general public.

The Hoteliers who received 3 Leaf and 1 Leaf rating certificates were encouraged to come up with improvements in coming period and try to get 5 Leaf rating certificate, a press release from DC, SA said.

ICAR-CIARI organizes Workshop on Import Substitution in Spices

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 4 In order to explore the prospects of commercial spices production and export from Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a workshop was organized by ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Sri Vijaya Puram on April 2, 2025 in virtual mode. Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary (Agri), A & N Administration lauded the efforts made by the ICAR-CIARI in organizing the important event with eminent experts in the field from pertinent organizations.

In her remarks, the Secretary (Agri.) thanked the experts for their valuable inputs and assured that the programme would be followed by action oriented stakeholders' meetings to carve a roadmap for promotion of spice cultivation and trade in the Islands. She also instructed the Departmental officials to take up necessary steps to develop mother gardens and nurseries in the Departmental farms and establish post harvest infrastructure in various production pockets of the Islands. Funding for these initiatives could be explored from various relevant schemes of the Department.

Earlier, Dr. E.B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, emphasized upon the importance of spice crops in the Island agriculture and their contribution in livelihood generation for the local farmers as well as traders. Dr. Ajit Arun Waman, Senior Scientist, ICAR-CIARI and Organizing Secretary of the event, gave a presentation on status and possibilities of quality spices production in the Islands. Dr. R. Praveena, Senior Scientist, ICAR-Indian Institute of Spices Research, Kozhikode gave a detailed presentation on sustainable production technologies for organic spices in Andamans.

Dr. Homey Cheriyan, Director, Directorate of Arecanut and Spices Development (Govt. of India), Kozhikode gave an insightful presentation on the import and export trends of spices from India. Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 4 G a r a c h a r a m a , D o l l y g u n j , consumer and general public have been informed that power supply will remain suspended in Pahargaon, ICMR Colony area, part of School Line and Water Treatment Plant area at Lamba Line, Bhatubasti complete, Laxmi Motor Area, Pathergudda, Satellite Colony, New Electricity P a h a r g a o n , G a r a c h a r m a , D o l l y g u n j , Attampahad, Minnie Bay and CIARI, Ayyanar Temple, Calicut, New Bimblitan, part of Teylarabad & Macca Pahad on 07.04.2025 and 08.04.2025 from 0600 hrs to 1200 hrs in connection with the commissioning of a new 10 MVA power transformer at 33/11 KV Garacharma Sub-Station, a press release from Electricity Department said.

ECBC Rules mandates all commercial buildings with a connected load of 50 kW or above or a contract demand of 60 kVA or above must comply with prescribed energy efficiency standards

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 4 The general public and consumers of Electricity Department have been informed that the Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC) Rules mandates that all commercial buildings with a connected load of 50 kW or above or a contract demand of 60 kVA or above must comply with the prescribed energy efficiency standards. This includes all newly constructed buildings and those undergoing additions or alterations that increase their energy demands.

The building owners are responsible for ensuring that energy conservation measures are incorporated into their building designs and are inspected for compliance. Upon completion an occupancy permit must be obtained from the concerned authority.

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVPMC) as the jurisdictional authority for urban areas has incorporated these ECBC provisions into its Bye Laws as notified in the Gazette as A&N Islands Energy Conservation Building Code Rule 2019 on 11.02.2021. Henceforth, for all such commercial buildings that fall within the purview of these rules, submission of necessary approval or clearance from the SVPMC is imperative for the owner (s) to obtain electric connection from Electricity Department for a connected load of 50 kW or above or a contract demand of 60 kVA or above.

It is needless to say that once the rules have been notified in A&N Gazette, it has to be implemented throughout A&N Islands without prejudice to any geographical or authority jurisdiction, a press release from Electricity Department said.
