



Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban 2.0

Beneficiaries urged to apply under suitable vertical as per their eligibility

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr.5 The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi has launched Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban 2.0, under which, financial assistance will be provided to 1 crore urban poor and middle-class families through States/Union Territories (UTs)/ PLIs to construct, purchase or rent a house at an affordable cost in urban areas in 5 years starting from 1st Sept., 2024.

A beneficiary family will comprise of husband, wife, unmarried sons and/or unmarried daughters. Families belonging to EWS/LIG/MIG segments, living in urban areas, should not own a pucca house (an all-weather dwelling unit) either in his/her name or in the name of any member of his/her family in any part of India. The Government assistance under PMAY-U 2.0 will be up to Rs. 2.50 lakh per unit.

The Scheme will be implemented through four verticals viz. Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), Affordable Rental Housing (ARH) and Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS) which will provide flexibility to the beneficiaries/States/UTs in choosing different options available under the Scheme.

Citizens have been requested to apply for the scheme under the suitable vertical as per their eligibility/requirement through the unified web portal in the website link <https://pmay-urban.gov.in/>.

Citizens are required to carefully read and understand the PMAY-U 2.0 scheme guidelines, which can be downloaded from the website link '<https://pmay-urban.gov.in/>', a press release from SVP/PMC said.

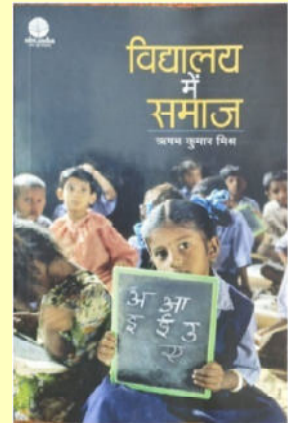


