Indian Armed forces carry out "Operation Sindoor" against terrorists; 9 terror infrastructures destroyed in Pakistan & PoJK

Prime Minister briefs Cabinet about "Operation Sindoor"; Hails Armed Forces

New Delhi, May 7
 Indian Armed Forces launched 'Operation Sindoor', post midnight, hitting terrorist infrastructure in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Jammu and Kashmir from where terrorist attacks against India have been planned and directed.

The Ministry of Defence in a statement, said, altogether, nine sites were targeted. The Ministry further added that its actions have been focused, measured and non-escalatory in nature. The Ministry informed that no Pakistani military facilities have been targeted. It added, India has demonstrated considerable restraint in selection of targets and method of execution.

The Defence Ministry said, these steps come in the wake of the barbaric Pahalgam terrorist attack in which 25 Indians and one Nepali citizen were killed. It said, armed forces are living up to the commitment that those responsible for this attack will be held accountable.



Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today hailed the Armed Forces for successfully conducting Operation Sindoor. He was

briefing the Union Cabinet in New Delhi for carrying out the Operation.

Sources said, the Prime Minister briefed them about the retaliatory action after the Pahalgam terror attack. Shri Modi was constantly monitoring the Operation Sindoor throughout the night. He was also lauded by the Union Ministers during the meeting.

Meanwhile, the Government has convened an all-party meeting tomorrow at 11 am in the wake of Operation Sindoor. During the meeting, the leaders of different political parties will be briefed by the Government on the operation.

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi also met President, Smti Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhawan this afternoon. The meeting came hours after India carried out Operation Sindoor at terror sites in Pakistan and Pakistan occupied Jammu and Kashmir. India exercises right to respond to terror: Foreign Secy. briefs nation on 'Operation Sindoor'

New Delhi, May 7
 India has exercised its sovereign right to respond to heinous acts of terror originating from across the border, the Government stated on Wednesday, hours after Indian armed forces launched precision strikes on terror camps in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK).

At a press conference on Operation Sindoor, Foreign Secretary, Shri Vikram Misri, flanked by Colonel Sofiya Qureshi and Wing Commander Vyomika Singh, emphasized that India's response to the recent Pahalgam attack was "measured, calibrated, and non-escalatory."

"Our objective was clear-to dismantle and decimate terror infrastructure across the border," Shri Misri said, noting that the operations were carried out with surgical precision and resulted in no collateral damage.

Calling Pakistan a "safe



haven for terrorists," Shri Misri accused the neighbouring country of continuing to shelter terror groups despite widespread international condemnation. He cited the case of Sajid Mir, a key 26/11 conspirator, as a stark example of Pakistan's duplicity.

"Pakistan had claimed Sajid Mir was dead. Only after sustained

international pressure did they 'resurrect' him and place him under arrest. This is among the most glaring examples of Pakistan's complicity in protecting terrorists," he remarked.

Shri Misri also described the Pahalgam massacre as a premeditated attempt by Pakistan-based elements to disrupt the growing peace and prosperity in Jammu and Kashmir.

"Last year, over 23 million tourists visited J&K. This surge in tourism threatens those invested in separatism.

Civil Defence Mock Drill conducted in South Andaman District

The Scenario was Air Raid Simulation near Jawaharlal Nehru Rajkeeya Mahavidyalaya (JNRM), Sri Vijaya Puram, A&N Islands that was followed by evacuation of present people on the site, Fire simulation, search and rescue, casualty evacuation of trapped people from the damaged building, their shifting in the nearby established temporary hospital and relief shelter.

The District Administration, South Andaman alongwith Civil Defence Volunteers and Emergency Support Functionaries (Disaster Management, A&N Police, Health, Fire & Emergency Services, NDRF, APWD, Electricity, NYK Volunteers, NCC, NSS, and all other line Department) of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands participated with great enthusiasm during entire exercise. The exercise was also witnessed by Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray and some other public representatives.

ECI crosses milestone of training over 2,300 field-level election functionaries at IIIDEM

New Delhi, May 7
The Election Commission of India has now taken another unprecedented step of training field-level election functionaries from Tamil Nadu and Puducherry in Tamil language. 293 participants comprising 264 BLO Supervisors, 14 EROs, 2 DEOs and other officials are part of this mixed-batch training programme at IIIDEM, Delhi.

In his inaugural address, Chief Election Commissioner (CEC), Shri Gyanesh Kumar said that the BLOs are the first interface of the Election Commission of India with the voters and have a vital role in ensuring correct and updated electoral rolls.

With this, nearly 2,300 participants have benefited from intensive training programmes being organised at IIIDEM during the past few weeks. This 2-day training programme is in line with the expansive training programme to train election functionaries at all levels including over 1 lakh BLOs in the country in next few years.

The BLO supervisors are being trained through interactive sessions, role plays, to ensure accurate filling of various forms including Form 6, 7 & 8. The module includes practical training in the use of IT solutions. These BLO supervisors are being equipped as Assembly Level Master Trainers to train other BLOs.

The participants were also familiarised with the provisions of first and second appeals against the final published electoral rolls with the District Magistrate (DM or an officer of equivalent rank) under section 24(a) of RP Act 1950 and Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of the State/UT under section 24(b) respectively.

It may be recalled that no appeals were filed from Tamil Nadu and Puducherry after the completion of the Special Summary Revision (SSR) exercise as of 6th-10th of January 2025. (Source: Election Commission of India)

entire exercise.

In accordance with the drill scenario, the ANC sent a message to SEOC about Air Attack at JNRM. The siren installed at JNRM, Sri Vijaya Puram briefly sounded during the exercise as part of the standard procedure. Blackout measures was also taken and practiced at the time of exercise. A temporary Hospital was established by Health Department at Andaman Club and Relief Shelter was setup at nearby Girls School on the direction of Incident Commander. All rescued persons were shifted to relief shelter and injured persons were shifted to temporary hospital for their primary treatment.

At the preparatory stage, the Incident Commander had taken pre briefing session on 06th May, 2025 at Aapda Prabhandan Bhawan and directed the appropriate resource Departments, Fire, Police, Electricity, NDRF & Health and others for support and assistance. The Fire & Police Department personnel & NDRF team effectively conducted safe evacuation and search and rescue operations. Ambulances and fire engines quickly arrived at the simulated location to rescue and treat the injured. The teams of Resource Departments carried out Search & Rescue and provided First Aid to the victims.

All activities were carried out in a controlled and supervised environment by trained professionals and coordinators. At 6 pm, the mock drill came to an end with a debriefing session. The Civil Defence Mock Drill is a preparedness exercise which seeks to identify strengths, weaknesses, and gaps in the current Civil Defence preparedness during emergencies like war, missile attacks, or aerial strikes. The drill was aimed to test the preparedness and efficiency of the current Civil Defence mechanisms at the UT and local levels. The exercise aimed at evaluating the response capabilities of various agencies, their coordination, and the public's preparedness to handle different types of emergencies, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

District Administration, SA imposes fines against illegal dumping of earth

The District Administration, South Andaman has taken strict action against violators who were indulged in illegal dumping of earth in contravention of Land Revenue Regulations.

During a recent field inspection at Garacharma village, revenue officials detected unauthorized dumping of approximately 30 cubic meters of earth. A fine of Rs. 18,000 was imposed on the offenders, and further legal action is being pursued.

The Deputy Commissioner has issued a stern warning to all such unscrupulous elements indulging in illegal mining, earth transportation and unauthorized dumping. Further, the District Administration, South Andaman reiterates that such illegal activities will not be tolerated. Strict penal action will be taken against all violators. The law will take its own course and those who attempt to bypass it, will face the consequences.

The general public have been advised to follow all legal provisions concerning land use, mining and material movement.

Massive jungle search operation in Cutbert Bay leads to largest methamphetamine seizure in N&MA District

Mayabunder, May 7
In a significant breakthrough in the ongoing crackdown against narcotics in the North & Middle Andaman District, a massive jungle search operation was conducted on May 4, 2025 in the dense forests of Cutbert Bay. This operation was launched in the wake of the recent seizures of methamphetamine from the same region and was carried out by a joint team from PS Billiground and PS Rangat, under the overall supervision of Shri Chandan G.S, SDPO Rangat.

A special team was constituted for the operation, comprising of SI M.V. Shiju Kumar, SHO PS Billiground, HC Diwbandu Biswas, PCs Samir Halder, Sujan Gharami, Bhagirath, P. Sagar from PS Billiground and PCs Mohd. Mustafa and T.K. Anas from PS Rangat. The team, accompanied by Scene of Crime Officer, Ms. A.P Nasreen and SDPO Rangat, proceeded for Cutbert Bay by an engine dinghy.

Upon arrival, the team proceeded into the jungle and launched a thorough search operation and subsequently discovered a white plastic sack lying unclaimed in a secluded bushy area containing 20 packets individually wrapped and marked as 'Gyanyinwang Refined Chinese Tea'.

Upon closer inspection, a strong odour and a suspicious white crystalline substance were detected. The contents were tested on-site using a drug detection kit confirming the presence of methamphetamine, a banned psychotropic substance. The total weight of the seized contraband was found to be 20.935 kg.

The banned substance was promptly seized with all legal protocols duly followed. Subsequently, a case has been registered under the relevant sections of NDPS Act, 1985 at PS Billiground and investigation has been taken up.

This seizure marks a major success in the ongoing efforts of Andaman & Nicobar Police against the menace of narcotics and reflects the unwavering commitment of the police force to keep the Islands drug-free.

The general public have been requested to pass and share any credible information pertaining to any crime or illegal activities to their nearest Police Station or over phone No.100, 112 & 03192-273344. The identity of the informers will be kept secret and will also be suitably rewarded.

The N&MA district is committed to keep the Islands drugs free to align with the aim of a 'Nasha Mukth Bharat', a press release from SP, N&MA said.

Fearing the erosion of their influence, they orchestrated this barbaric attack," he added.

The Foreign Secretary said the attack had provoked deep anger, not only in Jammu and Kashmir but across the country. He noted that India initially pursued diplomatic channels to hold Pakistan accountable, but ultimately resorted to targeted military action.

"Today, with Operation Sindoor, India has demonstrated its resolve to eliminate terror at its roots-precisely, decisively, and responsibly," Shri Misri concluded. (Source:india.gov.in)
