Prime Minister Chairs High-Level Meeting with Secretaries of Government of India

New Delhi, May 8 (PIB) The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today chaired a high-level meeting with Secretaries of various Ministries and Departments of the Government of India to review national preparedness and inter-ministerial coordination in light of recent developments concerning national security.

PM Modi stressed the need for seamless coordination among Ministries and agencies to uphold operational continuity and institutional resilience. PM reviewed the planning and preparation by Ministries to deal with the current situation.

Secretaries have been directed to undertake a comprehensive review of their respective Ministry's operations and to ensure fool-proof functioning of essential



systems, with special focus on readiness, emergency response, and internal communication protocols. Secretaries detailed their planning with a Whole of Government approach in the current situation. All Ministries have identified their actionables in relation to the conflict and are strengthening processes.

Ministries are ready to deal with all kinds of emerging situations. A range of issues were discussed during the meeting. These included, among others, strengthening of civil defence mechanisms, efforts to counter misinformation and fake news, and ensuring the security of critical infrastructure. Ministries were also advised to maintain close coordination with State authorities and ground-level institutions.

The meeting was attended by the Cabinet Secretary, senior officials from the Prime Minister's Office, and Secretaries from key Ministries including Defence, Home Affairs, External Affairs, Information & Broadcasting, Power, Health, and Telecommunications.

The Prime Minister called for continued alertness, institutional synergy, and clear communication as the nation navigates a sensitive period. He reaffirmed the Government's commitment to national security, operational preparedness, and citizen safety.

India reiterates Pakistan's reputation as centre of global terrorism

New Delhi, May 8 Foreign Secretary, Shri Vikram Misri today said that Pakistan's reputation as centre of global terrorism is rooted in various terrorist attacks across the globe. Briefing media in New Delhi this evening, Shri Misri said, any further action by Pakistan, some of which we are seeing today, is nothing but escalation by Pakistan once again, and will be responded to and is being responded to appropriately. He said, attack of Pahalgam terror attack is the original escalation to which India has responded. Shri Misri said, when talks were going on about the Pahalgam at the UN Security Council, Pakistan opposed the role of The Resistance Front (TRF) and it was done after TRF claimed the responsibility of the attack not once, but twice.



accepted their involvement with such terror groups. He also shown a picture of the state funerals given to terrorists killed in Operation Sindoor. The Foreign Secretary said, yesterday Pakistan launched a targeted attack on the Sikh community of Jammu and Kashmir hitting a Gurdwara in Poonch and hitting the Sikh community members, who came under attack. On Indus Waters Treaty, Shri Misri said, Pakistan was deliberately creating roadblocks over the years.

Colonel Sofiya Qureshi and Wing Commander Vyomika Singh said, Pakistan attempted to engage several military targets in northern and western India using drones and missiles. These locations included Avantipura, Srinagar, Jammu, Pathankot, Amritsar, Kapurthala, Nal, Jalandhar, Ludhiana, Adhampur, Bhatinda, Chandigarh, Falaudi, Uttarlai, and Bhuj. They said, these attempts were neutralized by the integrated counter-unmanned aerial system and other air defense systems. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Wing Commander Singh said, Pakistan has increased the intensity of its unprovoked firing across the Line of Control using Mortars and heavy calibre Artillery in areas in Kupwara, Baramulla, Uri, Poonch, Mendhar and Rajouri sectors in Jammu and Kashmir. 16 innocent lives have been lost, including three women and five children, due to Pakistani firing. They said, India was compelled to respond to bring Mortar and Artillery fire from Pakistan to a halt. They said, Indian Armed Forces reiterate their commitment to non-escalation, provided it is respected by the Pakistani military.

South Andaman Forest Division destroys significant quantity of illicit liquor

During routine beat patrolling in Habdipur Reserved Forest Area under South Andaman Forest Division, forest team members comprising Beat Officer Shri. Anoop Singh (Forester) and departmental mazdoors detected illicit country liquor preparation site inside the dense forest area yesterday.

On further investigation, the team found 90 liters of Lahan (Fermented base for making country liquor) along with used utensils i.e. 1 plastic bucket (Big size), 1 plastic container, 1 Iron cask, 3 Tin containers (medium size) and 1 Kadai (small size) in a



small cleared patch inside the forest area. The team tried to search for the offenders in the forest area but nobody was found. Following the seizure by the Beat Officer, Ograbraj, all confiscated 90 liters of Lahan (Fermented base for making country liquor) was destroyed on the spot and the remaining seized items were brought and handed over to

Camp Officer, Head Quarter, Tushnabad Range under South Andaman Division for safe custody.

The entire operation was conducted under the supervision of Forest Range Officer, Tushnabad Range with active guidance by Assistant Conservator of Forests (South Andaman Forest Division), a press release from DFO (SA) said.

conclude 'Fast-tracking of Quality Assurance through Integrated Approach and Technology Enabled Processes', Shri Rajnath Singh stated that fast-tracking quality assessment is the need of the hour in view of the disruptive changes and new transformations being witnessed in the defence sector across the globe.

Raksha Mantri voiced the Government's emphasis on the empowerment of the defence production sector since 2014, based on Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's philosophy of Defence Sovereignty. He said: "Defence Sovereignty means that until a country is capable and self-reliant in its defence needs, its independence cannot be considered complete. If we buy weapons and other defence equipment from abroad, we are outsourcing our security and leaving it at the mercy of someone else. Our Government thought over it seriously and took a decisive step to achieve self-reliance. The expanding defence industrial ecosystem is providing an unprecedented strength to India".

Shri Rajnath Singh added that equal emphasis is being laid on quality and quantity in defence production with many revolutionary steps being taken in that direction, including corporatisation of Ordnance Factory Board (OFB). He termed Quality as the Government's priority Reform Agenda, highlighting that since the corporatisation of OFB, DPSUs have become internationally competitive and export-oriented, with efforts being made to advance quality production.

Raksha Mantri pointed out that one of the objectives behind the progress of the public sector has been to develop a Healthy Competitive Private Defence Ecosystem, which will strengthen India's security through quality. "In today's world, a strong brand value is important than just a product. The brand, which assures consistent quality and reliability, succeeds," he said.

Shri Rajnath Singh appealed to the Armed Forces, Government QA agencies, DPSUs, private industry, research institutions, academia, and MSME representatives present on the occasion to build a world-leading state-of-the-art Brand India. "Brand India means if an Indian company has promised something, it will definitely happen. 'Whenever in doubt, go for India' should be our USP," he said.

On the major changes being witnessed in the global order, Raksha Mantri stated that when developed countries move towards rearmament, the demand for arms & equipment will increase. He cited the report of Stockholm International Peace Research Institute which said that the world military expenditure has reached \$ 2,718 billion in 2024. He expressed hope that with coordinated efforts, the Indian defence manufacturing sector can make its mark globally with the Brand India philosophy. "Defence exports crossed the record figure of about Rs 24,000 crore in Financial Year 2024-25. Our aim is to increase the figure to Rs 50,000 crore by 2029. The target is to make India a developed nation and the world's largest defence exporter by 2047. To achieve the goal, we must develop global trust regarding the quality of our defence equipment," he said.

While Shri Rajnath Singh acknowledged the efforts being made towards quality improvement, he stressed on the need to focus on using tools such as artificial intelligence, internet of things, and machine learning for real-time quality monitoring in today's technology-driven era. He also called for updating standards and testing protocols to align with evolving global technologies. We need to focus on time-bound quality assurance clearances so that unwanted delays do not take place, he said.

Raksha Mantri added that quality assessment agencies should always keep an eye on their deficiencies and work on overcoming them through modernisation and development of testing infrastructure. Continuous gap analysis in the field of niche technology will be an essential step, he said.
